The following is a list of what to bring to your eye examination in our office:

- All insurance cards including vision plans and major medical/secondary insurance
- The name of your primary care physician or other specialists
- Any prescription eyeglasses you currently wear
- Your prescription or non prescription sunglasses
- A list of your medication and dosages
 - If you have diabetes please bring your dosages of insulin or oral medications
- If you wear contact lenses please bring:
 - The current boxes/vials OR a valid prescription written by another provider
 - The name brand or bottle of any solution and drops used for your contact lenses
 - Any glasses used over contact lenses such as sun glasses or reading glasses
- Please remember all new patients will be dilated and while most do just fine, you may wish to bring a driver. We highly recommend bringing sunglasses if you have a daytime appointment.
- We strongly recommend digital retinal photographs of all new patients. These images will enable us to establish a baseline for future visits and helps us monitor your ocular health in a more comprehensive manner. This procedure is not covered by insurance but is priced reasonably at only \$35.
